Starting this fall, more than 12 bursaries of up to \$5,000 each will be available to support municipal and Indigenous government staff from across Canada to attend Community Solutions Network events. Bursaries may be used to cover travel costs to attend one of the following events. Successful candidates will be notified at least two weeks prior to the event.

### **Eligibility criteria:**

- Bursaries of up to \$5,000 will be available to support travel-related costs to attend the [Community Solutions Network events](#).
- The bursary program is open to staff of Canadian municipalities with populations of less than 50,000 or staff of local and regional First Nations, Métis, and Inuit governments.

### **About the selection process:**

- At least 12 bursaries will be awarded across the country.
- A selection committee of experts will review applications and make funding decisions on the basis of eligibility, relevance, need and the likelihood of impact.
- As a founding partner in the Future Cities Canada program, CFC is working with community foundations across the country to build awareness and ensure that smaller and more remote communities have the opportunity to participate in Community Solutions Network events.

Stay tuned for a second call for bursary applications for an event in the North to be added this fall.
